

The Schedule 2 invoice identifies the claim number, name of the injured worker, type of benefit, date benefit was paid, date benefit payment was made and the amount of the benefit payment.

Benefit Type

The benefit category identifies the type of benefit payments made either to, or on behalf of, the injured worker.
